CONSTITUTION.

Act to provide in certain Cases for the Alteration of 58 & 59 Vic. c. 34 COLONIAL the Boundaries of Colonies. Boundaries Act, 1895.

[6th July, 1895.]

E it enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and many mmons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of ne same, as follows:-

1. (1.) Where the boundaries of a colony have, either before or Alteration of for the passing of this Act, been altered by Her Majesty the Queen by boundaries or der in Council or letters patent the boundaries as so altered shall be, the deemed to have been from the date of the alteration, the boundaries the Colony.

(2.) Provided that the consent of a self-governing colony shall be

equired for the alteration of the boundaries thereof.

(3.) In this Act "self-governing colony" means any of the colonies medified in the Schedule to this Act.

2. This Act may be cited as the Colonial Boundaries Act, 1895.
