An Act to Amend the Law relating to Selections under "The Crown Lands Alienation Act of 1868" and "The Homestead Areas Act of 1872."

[ASSENTED TO 22ND AUGUST, 1878.]

WHEREAS it is desirable to amend the Law relating to Selections Preamble.
under "The Crown Lands Alienation Act of 1868" and Homestead Selections under "The Homestead Areas Act of 1872" Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Queensland in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows—

1. From and after the passing of this Act the eighth section of "The Homestead Areas Act of 1872" shall be read and construed as if the period of five years therein mentioned were three years and the said recited Act shall be amended accordingly. Period of obtaining grant of land under 36 Vic. No. 20 shortened.

2. From and after the passing of this Act the second subsection of section 51 of "The Crown Lands Alienation Act of 1868" shall be read and construed as if the amount one-fourth therein mentioned were one-tenth and the last-mentioned Act shall be amended accordingly. Fine for non-payment of rent on selection under 31 Vic. No. 46 reduced.

3. This Act may be cited as "The Selectors Relief Act of 1878." Short title.
